**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

between

Laboratory of Corporate Law of the F.G.Burchak "Scientific Research Institute of Private Law and Business of Nationality Academy of Law Sciences of Ukraine" represented by prof. dr. hab. Oleksandr Krupchan

hereinafter referred to as "Parties", having an intention to establish scientific, research and educational cooperation have decided to sign the present Memorandum.

**Article 1**

The scientific, research and educational cooperation will cover the following areas:

- 1) Preparing compilation of corporate legislation of signatory parties' countries;
- 2) Providing explanations and interpretation of corporate legislation for the signatory parties;
- 3) Joint research in the field of Private Law and other branches of Law (Criminal Law, Environmental Law etc);
- 4) Joint conferences;
- 5) Creating a bilateral (in future international) common web-site, forum on Corporate Law enforcement;
- 6) Creating and publishing of:
  - Manual for investors and lawyers (Corporate Law, Civil Law, Tax Law and Registration Procedure);
  - Textbook of Comparative Corporate Law (between Poland and Ukraine);
- 7) Exchange of scientific law literature;
- 8) Publishing of articles in the magazines of signatory parties' faculties;
- 9) Exchange of lecturers.

**Article 2**

Detailed terms of cooperation, especially with regard to the methods of financing and particular staff or student exchange schemes, shall be specified each time in separate attachments to this Memorandum.

**Article 3**

This Memorandum shall continue for 3 years. Amendments to this Memorandum or particular stages of joint activities may be made only by writing with the approval of three Parties. This Memorandum may be terminated by either Party with a three-month written notice.

**Article 4**

This Memorandum is signed in three copies in English. Each Party receives one copy of the Memorandum.


**Article 5**

This Memorandum shall be in force from the date of signing by three Parties and approval by the Board of Faculty of Law, Canon Law and Administration.
